Sunday 23 February

- **Moderator** | Open Doors has a Watch list of some 50 countries where Christians are persecuted for their faith. Pray for the endurance of these Christians in the spirit of Hebrews 13:3, "Remember those who are in prison as though in prison with them; and those who are ill treated, since you also are in the body."
- Worship: Delighted in the wisdom of God's truth | "Your statutes are my delight; they are my counsellors." Psalm 119:24.

Monday 24 February

- **Diane Cusick, global mission worker, Zambia** | Pray for Diane as she travels to Zimbabwe and Malawi to visit Early Childhood Development Centres. Pray for encouraging conversations and for good health and safety in travel.
- **Presbyterian Church of Myanmar (PCM), Myanmar |** Please pray for the PCM as they continue to live in the midst of conflict which has been ongoing since the military coup four years ago. Wednesday 26 February

Thursday 27 February

- Mission in Ireland evenings, Council for Mission in Ireland (CMI) | Pray for all those who are speaking at the Presbytery Mission in Ireland evenings in the coming weeks. Pray that these events would be informative, encouraging and inspiring to all those who attend.
- Part-time healthcare chaplains | Pray for all chaplains who seek to come alongside those in hospital, their families and hospital staff, alongside their other duties. Give thanks for opportunities to share God's love in these circumstances.

Friday 28 February

- **Kinghan Church** | Situated on Botanic Avenue in South Belfast, Kinghan Church ministers to the deaf community. Give thanks for those who attend weekly worship and lunch club along with various activities. Pray for the staff team Judith and Claire, and those who lead Sunday worship. We praise God for such a place as Kinghan.
